



***Walkway Over the Hudson State Historic Park

Come walk across the Hudson River with breathtaking, unobstructed 360 degree views of the Hudson River and surrounding scenic valley with Fall Foliage from 212 feet above the Hudson River. The Walkway Over the Hudson spans the Hudson River and connects the City of Poughkeepsie in Dutchess County with the Town of Lloyd and hamlet of Highland in Ulster County, New York. Total Distance 1 way from parking lot is to the end of the historic park on the side of the river is approximately 1.5miles. (~3.0 miles round trip). This is a family and Dog Friendly (on Leash Only) park. On the way back we may stop at one of the local restaurants for a bite to eat before driving back to Albany.

11:00AM - Begin Leisurely Walk across Hudson River towards Poughkeepsie

~2:00PM—Arrive Back at Parking Lot

2:30PM – , Depart parking lot to head back to Albany or to restaurant for Food.

4:30PM – Return to CBE Parking Lot (No Food Stop)

6:00PM Return to CBE Parking Lot (Stop For Food)
